

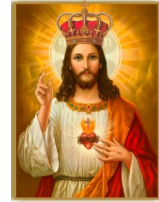

He told us of his plans for the parishes. The current unit of four parishes is to be split once again.

Wells & Cheddar:

Cheddar and Wells will have their own parish priest, who will be resident in the presbytery in Wells. Your new parish priest will be Fr Tony Pazhayakalam CST. He hails from Kerala in India, and is a member of the Little Flower Congregation. (You can find out more about his Order at www.cstfathersindia.com) We know you will make him very welcome. At the moment he is based in Cheltenham, and he intends to arrive at the end of the year.

Shepton Mallet & Glastonbury:

Shepton Mallet & Glastonbury will not have a resident priest at this time, but the Bishop intends that they will in the future. In the meantime the Bishop will be organising supply priests, to ensure that there will be Mass every Sunday for both parishes.

General Notices

SUNDAY OBLIGATION

Since the earliest days of the Church it has been an expectation that Christians would give glory to God on the first day of the week (Sunday), every week, by attending Mass. (In addition there are other Holy Days which are also of Obligation, namely Christmas, the Epiphany, The Ascension, SS Peter and Paul, The Assumption, and All Saints).

The Obligation may be fulfilled by attending Mass either on Sunday, or on the vigil, the previous evening. The Bishops of England and Wales have decreed that **the Solemn Obligation to attend Sunday Mass will be applied with effect from the weekend of 27/28th November.**

We may have good reason to miss Mass, for instance due to frailty, ill health, lack of transport etc, in which case there is of course no sin. (For further details, please ask one of the priests). However, if we deliberately do not go to Mass on a Sunday without good reason, we will need to go to Confession before we next receive Holy Communion.
