Time to Start School? If you have a child born between **1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019**, then **now** is the time to apply for a place at a Catholic primary school in the Diocese. You must complete an application form (either online or on paper) that is available from the school admissions team of the *Somerset County Council*, for admission during the **2023-24** school year. If your child has been baptised, you **must** also provide a copy of the baptism certificate to your preferred school. Please ensure you apply by the closing date of **15 January 2023**.
